

# Hi, we are your Future Counselors

## Grades 9 - 12

Ever wonder what it is like to be a counselor? Spend a week learning the ropes of becoming a camp counselor. Girls going into the 11th-12th grades are eligible to apply to be a Counselor In Training. Once accepted, more information will follow.

CIT I is perfect for girls who have not completed a CIT session. CIT I involves time spent in different units with each age group observing and aiding the counselors in each unit. Don't worry, there will be time for swimming, canoeing, and the like.

CIT II offers girls who have previously completed the CIT I program an opportunity to learn, more in depth, what it is like to be a camp counselor. If accepted to participate in CIT II, girls will spend multiple days with one specific age group. Campers will assist camp staff in everything from waking the campers, helping direct unit activities, assisting with general

camp programs, as well as helping with bed time. Get ready to experience a full day plus time for fun, relaxation, and all those crazy camp traditions!

Girls interested in becoming a CIT should register by completing the camp registration form. Upon receipt of the camp registration form, a CIT application will be mailed to you, along with two reference forms. The CIT application and reference forms need to be completed and returned by April 15, 2010. You will also have a telephone interview with the camp director. No payment is necessary until you are accepted into the program. You will be notified by April 31, if you are selected to participate in the CIT program. The Counselor-In-Training Program is a two-week program designed to prepare girls with practical experience and develop leadership skills for the future in a camp setting.

### Program Aid Training & Everything Camp

You will have one class time in Program Aid and one session with your younger girls and then the other half of the day will be with your buddies doing what older girls love to do! ### Wrangler-in-Training

The Wrangler-in-Training (WIT) program enables girls to better understand the Girl Scout practices and principles related to camping and horsemanship. Responsibilities will include assisting the Horse Director in the planning and overseeing of activities, assisting the barn aides with all daily kapers at the barn and ensuring that the campers in her care are always safe.
