- Exhibits courage, confidence, and character and makes the world a better place.
- Has set a good example for girls and has made a positive impact in the community.
- Is over the age of 18.
- **All nominees will be invited to attend and will be recognized at an awards ceremony on Thursday, April 18, 2019, at Wynlakes Golf & Country Club. The event will be a brunch from 10-11:30 a.m.**

Awardees are selected for their demonstration of courage, confidence, and character, which makes the world a better place. Once awardees are selected, all nominees and their nominators will be notified of the status of their nomination.
