- Creates opportunities to support and develop women's leadership within the workplace.
- Recognizes the importance of women's professional leadership in developing role models for girls.
- **All nominees will be invited to attend and will be recognized at an awards ceremony on Thursday, April 18, 2019, at Wynlakes Golf & Country Club.**

Once awardees are selected, all nominees and their nominators will be notified of the status of their nomination.
