- Resides in one of the 30 counties served by southern Alabama: Autauga, Baldwin, Barbour, Bullock, Butler, Chambers, Choctaw, Clarke, Coffee, Conecuh, Coosa, Covington, Crenshaw, Dale, Dallas, Elmore, Escambia, Geneva, Henry, Houston, Lee, Lowndes, Macon, Mobile, Monroe, Montgomery, Pike, Tallapoosa, Washington and Wilcox.
- Exhibits courage, confidence, and character and makes the world a better place.
- Has set a good example for girls and has made a positive impact in the community.
- Is over the age of 18.
- **Selected awardees will be invited to attend an awards reception on June 27, 2019 from 5:30 p.m.- 7:30 p.m. at Moe's Original BBQ, Downtown Mobile**
