Purpose of Position

A Media G.I.R.L.'s role is to share their personal experiences and skills learned through participation in Girl Scouts, as well as general information about Girl Scouts, in order to enhance the visibility and relevance of Girl Scouts. If chosen and all responsibilities are completed, the press rep will receive a Media G.I.R.L. patch!

Media G.I.R.L. Responsibilities

1. Write and submit three articles with pictures about Girl Scout activities
2. Provide 24-hour notice if you must cancel an engagement
3. Be willing to attend media interviews, membership drives, council events, etc. if schedule permits

Qualifications

1. Submit application and essay or video (see #2) before deadline
2. In 500 words or less, submit a video or write an essay on what the Girl Scout Promise and Law means to you and why
3. Sign and return Image Release Content and Position Agreement
4. Ability to establish a good rapport with Girl Scout members, media and community
5. Ability to communicate clearly with diverse groups of people
6. Appreciation of the Girl Scout program and its impact in the community
7. Willingness to communicate Girl Scout issues and activities with outside organizations
8. Must be a registered Girl Scout

Press Rep activities vary; they may include writing articles, public speaking, attending council events, and more. Press reps will be required to write at least three articles during the year about Girl Scout activities for possible publication.

Parents, it is very important to note that most representation for the council will be internal to the Girl Scout community – through our website, social media, and newsletters.

To apply, submit the following application and in 500 words or less tell us if you're a go-getter, innovator, risk-taker or leader (or any/all) and why, by July 5. The Girl Scout can choose to submit a video instead of a written essay. Applications will be reviewed and confirmations sent by July 10.
