Volunteer Years of Service Pin Nomination

Recognizes an adult in Girl Scouting for her/his active years of service at five-year intervals. This award differs from the numeral guard in that it represents the number of years an adult volunteer has actively provided service, whereas the numeral guard recognizes years of membership (both girl and adult).

Process: For nominees who have completed at least 15 years of adult volunteer service, nominator may submit the nomination form for presentation at the annual council meeting. For nominees who have completed 5 or 10 years of adult volunteer service, nominator may submit form for presentation at the Service Unit level. Submit forms to the service center in your area with appropriate approval signature. This earned award can be self-nominated or by an individual or group familiar with the candidate's performance but must be approved by the Service Unit Team.

For 15 or more years and presentation at annual council meeting, the nomination form is due on or before the last Friday in February.

For 5 or 10 years and presentation at Service Unit, nomination form is due on or before the last Friday in March.
