

President's Volunteer Service Award

Any individual, family, or group can receive Presidential recognition for volunteer hours earned over a 12-month period or over the course of a lifetime. Refer to the [President's Volunteer Service Award website](#) for more information. The following are the eligibility requirements for each age group:

Kids: Age 5-10

Teens: Age 11-15

Young Adults: Individual Age 16-25

Adults: Individual Age 26 +

Presidential Volunteer Service Award Criteria



Bronze Level:

Kids: 26 to 49 hours

Teens: 50 to 74 hours

Young Adults: 100 to 174 hours

Adults: 100 to 249 hours

Family & Groups: 200 to 499 hours



Silver Level:

Kids: 50 to 74 hours

Teens: 75 to 99 hours

Young Adults: 175 to 249 hours

Adults: 250 to 499 hours

Family & Groups: 500 to 999 hours



Gold Level:

Kids: 75 hours or more

Teens: 100 hours or more

Young Adults: 250 hours or more

Adults: 500 hours or more

Family & Groups: 1000 hours or more
