



How Long Am I Certified?

For the safety and well-being of our members, Girl Scouts requires that adult volunteers be trained/certified for specific roles they take on for their Troop. Not every Troop needs all roles (such as an Archery or Zip Line Certified Adult). However, for a Troop to participate in these activities, a certified person must be facilitating it for them (as specified in the Safety Activity Checkpoints).

Every Volunteer	Eligible background check result	3 years
Troop Coordinator	gsLearn: 307 New Coordinator Training	Required only once
Meeting Coordinator	gsLearn: 307 New Coordinator Training	Required only once
Finance Coordinator	gsLearn: Finance Coordinator Training	Required only once
Munchies & Mags Coordinator	gsLearn: Finance Coordinator + GSSA Fall Product Training	Product Training to be completed annually
Cookie Coordinator	gsLearn: Finance Coordinator + GSSA Cookie Training	Product Training to be completed annually
FA/CPR Certified Adult	Nationally Recognized First Aid/CPR Certification	2 years
Outdoor Essentials Certified Adult	GSSA Outdoor Essentials Training + Knowledge Check	5 years
Archery Certified Facilitator	Certification through GSSA, NASP, or USA Archery	3 years
Zip Line Certified Adult (2 required)	GSSA Zip Line Certification	3 years
Small Craft Certified Adult	GSSA Small Watercraft Certification	3 years
