2026 Girl Scout Cookie Program

Program Information

- •Girl Scout Cookies are \$6 per package, with the exception of Toffee-tastics, which are \$7. Cookies may not be sold for any other prices.
- Toffee-tastics will be available for troop initial orders and online direct-ship orders in Digital Cookie. Toffee-tastics will not be stocked in GSSA cupboard locations.
- •Cookie booths, stands, and walkabouts may only take place in the 30 counties included in the Girl Scouts of Southern Alabama council area.
- •Troops earn 80¢ per package. Troops that opt out of earning girl incentives and program credits will receive patches and earn 83¢ per package. If your troop is opting out, please make your selection in eBudde before Feb. 10.
- •All donations received during the Girl Scout Cookie Program must go toward Hometown Heroes.
- •Cookie links can be shared with family and friends using personal social media pages, text, and email.
- Cookie links cannot be shared on community social media pages or public sales sites, such as Facebook Marketplace, eBay, local buy/sell/trade pages, etc. Cookie links cannot be shared with television, print, or digital news media.
- •Troop Cookie Coordinators should collect a signed Permission and Financial Responsibility agreement from each grown-up that is supporting a Girl Scout's cookie sale. Do not distribute cookies to a caregiver without a signed agreement.
- •You are encouraged to hold your cookie program family meeting prior to Dec. 8, when Girl Scouts will begin registering in Digital Cookie.
- If you must cancel a cookie booth site reservation, always cancel in eBudde. Please cancel 24-48 hours in advance, if possible.

- •Troop Cookie Coordinator registered and approved
- •80% of Girl Scouts participating
- ·Initial Order of 40 cases or more
- Minimum of 3 booth sales in eBudde with corresponding transactions
- •2 or more planned orders picked up from cupboard
- •Troop per girl average (PGA) of 150 packages or more
- Successful final ACH on or after March 17

PRODUCT PROGRAM BONUS: \$.75 per case sold

•Troops who meet **all** requirements for Fall Product and Cookie Bonuses will receive **\$.75 per case**, instead of receiving the Fall Product Bonus and Cookie Bonus separately.

Cupboard Orders

DUE SUNDAYS BEFORE 11:59 p.m.

- Cupboard orders placed in eBudde by Sunday night are prioritized over walk-in requests.
- Cupboard orders will appear as "pending" in eBudde until the pick up has been made and confirmed by the cupboard manager. *If necessary, quantities may be adjusted when you arrive at the cupboard for pick-up.*

Please select delivery station while placing IO.

DEC. 8 (Mon) Cookie Program Sales Begin

Girl Scouts register for Digital Cookie.

Direct-ship sales begin.

DEC 13-14 (Sat & Sun) FREE Shipping Promotion

Orders of 8-12 packages only

JAN 2, 2026 (Fri) Girl-Delivery Presale Begins

Girl Scouts can begin receiving order card and Digital Cookie orders for girl-delivery.

JAN 4 | 12 P.M. (Sun) Booth Site Selection Begins

Up to 3 booths each day at 3 different locations.

JAN 5-9 (Mon-Fri) Troops Pickup Initial Orders

JAN 9-11 (Fri-Sun) Walkabout Weekend

Girl Scouts have cookies in-hand and can go door-to-door with the help of their grown-ups or troop.

JAN 11 | 12 p.m. (Sun) Booth Site Selection

Up to 5 booths each day at 5 different locations.

JAN 17 (Sat) Cookie Booth Sales Begin

Ensure all volunteers and Girl Scouts review and adhere to cookie booth etiquette provided by GSSA.

JAN 18 | 12 p.m. (Sun) Booth Selection Unrestricted

Please do not sign up for booths you do not intend to use.

FEB 10 (Tues) First ACH begins

Includes 1/2 the amount due to GSSA for IO and all cupboard pickups through Feb. 8. *ACH may occur after this date.*

FEB 13-15 (Fri-Sun) Hometown Heroes Weekend

The troop with the most Hometown Heroes donations will receive free Hometown Heroes patches!

FEB 20-22 (Fri-Sun) National GS Cookie Weekend

MARCH 8 (Sun) Girl Scout Cookie Program Ends

Troop Cookie Coordinators assist families with settling finances and finalizing Girl Scouts' cookie sales.

MARCH 12 (Thurs) Final Girl Incentive Selections

Due in eBudde

MARCH 17 (Tues) Final ACH Begins

Includes all outstanding balances owed. *ACH may occur after this date.*

APRIL 20 (Mon) Girl Incentives Expected to Arrive from Little Brownie Bakers

Accepting Customer Payments

- Digital Cookie Girls and troops can process credit card payments for customers using Digital Cookie for in-person, girl delivery, or direct-ship sales. Customers can pay via Venmo and PayPal in Digital Cookie for in-person sales *only*.
- •Other Digital payment options (CashApp, Square, etc.) may be connected to troop bank accounts, but the troop will be responsible for paying any associated fees.
- Cash Cash should be secured in a cash box or adult's waist pouch immediately. Girls should never carry cash.
- Checks Girls and troops can accept checks from customers they know, but should not accept checks from strangers or checks over \$25 in value. Checks should be written out to the troop bank account.

Managing Troop Funds

- Share your deadlines and expectations for the collection of money with girls and families. Remind caregivers that they are financially responsible for all cookies signed for and received by their Girl Scout.
- ALWAYS issue receipts for cookies you distribute and payments you received.
- Payments for cookies ordered and shipped through Digital Cookie are automatically posted to your troop's record in eBudde and will offset money due via ACH.
- Troops should deposit all money collected into their troop account quickly and frequently.
- Remember, proceeds become part of the troop's treasury and are not given to, nor belong to, any individual girl(s).
- Collect money for cookies in-hand before allowing caregivers to receive more. Even then, only issue cookies in small amounts, requiring payment before they can receive more.
- If you have a caregiver who has not complied with the troop's payment deadline(s), do **NOT** distribute more cookies to them.







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
